1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 13.32, subdivision 5, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 5. Directory information. Information designated as directory information
1.8	pursuant to the provisions of United States Code, title 20, section 1232g and Code of
1.9	Federal Regulations, title 34, section 99.37 which are in effect on January $\frac{1}{2007}$ $\underline{3}$,
1.10	2012, is public data on individuals, to the extent required under federal law. When
1.11	conducting the directory information designation and notice process required by federal
1.12	law, an educational agency or institution shall give parents and students notice of the
1.13	right to refuse to let the agency or institution designate any or all data about the student
1.14	as directory information. This notice may be given by any means reasonably likely to
1.15	inform the parents and students of the right.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
