1.6	Section 1. MAPLEWOOD; HARRIET TUBMAN CENTER EAST RENOVATION
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,577,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.9	Maplewood to design, construct, renovate, furnish, and equip capital improvements to the
1.10	Harriet Tubman Center East building, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695. This
1.11	appropriation includes money for accessibility improvements, partial replacement of the
1.12	roof, electrical system improvements, and construction of a commercial kitchen. This
1.13	appropriation does not require a nonstate contribution.
1.14	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.15	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.16	the state in an amount up to \$2,577,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.17	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.18	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
