1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 256J.24, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **MFIP transitional standard.** The MFIP transitional standard is based
1.8 on the number of persons in the assistance unit eligible for both food and cash assistance
1.9 unless the restrictions in subdivision 6 on the birth of a child apply. ~~The amount of the~~
1.10 ~~transitional standard is published annually by the Department of Human Services. The~~

1.12 and food portions effective October 1, 2013.
