1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing the city of Springfield to issue an on-sale license.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. SPECIAL LICENSE; CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

1.5 The city of Springfield may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license, an on-sale wine
1.6 and strong beer license, or an on-sale including Sunday intoxicating liquor license for the
1.7 city-owned facility known as the Springfield Area Community Center, notwithstanding any
1.8 law, local ordinance, or charter provision. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter
1.9 340A, not inconsistent with this section, apply to the license issued under this section. The
1.10 city of Springfield is deemed the licensee under this section, and the provisions of Minnesota
1.11 Statutes, sections 340A.603 and 340A.604, apply to the license as if the facility was a
1.12 municipal liquor store.

1.13 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon approval by the Springfield City
1.14 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
