1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education; increasing state aid for the school breakfast program;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.1158, subdivisions 3, 4, by  
1.4 adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.1158, is amended by adding a  
1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 2a. **Definitions.** For the purposes of this section, the terms defined in section  
1.9 120A.05 have the meanings given them.

1.10 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.1158, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.11 Subd. 3. **Program reimbursement.** Each school year, the state must reimburse  
1.12 each participating school 30 cents for each reduced-price breakfast, 55 cents for each  
1.13 fully paid breakfast served to students in grades 1 to 12 middle school and secondary  
1.14 school, and \$1.30 for each fully paid breakfast served to a kindergarten student students in  
1.15 elementary school.

1.16 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.1158, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.17 Subd. 4. **No fees.** A school that receives school breakfast aid under this section must  
1.18 make breakfast available without charge to all participating students in grades 1 to 12  
1.19 middle school and secondary school who qualify for free or reduced-price meals and to all  
1.20 kindergarten elementary school students.
