1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 462A.2035, is amended to read:
1.7	462A.2035 MANUFACTURED HOME PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Establishment. The agency shall establish a manufactured home park
1.9	redevelopment program for the purpose of making manufactured home park redevelopment
1.10	grants or loans to cities, counties, or community action programs, nonprofit organizations,
1.11	and cooperatives created under chapter 308A or 308B.
1.12	Subd. 1a. Individual assistance grants. Cities, counties, and community action programs
1.13	Eligible recipients may use individual assistance grants and loans under this program to:
1.14	(1) provide current residents of manufactured home parks with buy-out assistance not
1.15	to exceed \$4,000 per home with preference given to older manufactured homes; and
1.16	(2) provide down-payment assistance for the purchase of new and preowned manufactured
1.17	homes that comply with the current version of the State Building Code in effect at the time
1.18	of the sale, not to exceed \$10,000 per home; and.
1.19	(3) make improvements in manufactured home parks as requested by the grant recipient.
