Section 1. MASONIC TEMPLE.

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

fund to the commissioner of economic development for a grant to the city of Minneapolis

for improvements and betterments of a capital nature to renovate the historic Masonic

Temple at the Hennepin Center for the Arts, in Minneapolis, subject to Minnesota

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
