A bill for an act

relating to local government; providing and clarifying the compatibility of concurrently holding certain offices; amending Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 375.09, subdivision 1; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 123B; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 367.033.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **[123B.196] COMPATIBILITY OF SCHOOL BOARD OFFICE WITH OTHER ELECTED OFFICES.**

A school board member of a school district, however organized, may serve concurrently as a member of a city council, a board of county commissioners, or a town board.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 375.09, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **No county employment or other elected office; school district office exception.** Except as authorized under section 123B.196 for service on a school board, no county commissioner shall hold another elected office during tenure as commissioner nor be employed by the county.

Sec. 3. **REPEALER.**

Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 367.033, is repealed.

APPENDIX
Repealed Minnesota Statutes: 13-1053

367.033 MAY BE ON BOTH TOWN AND SCHOOL BOARD EXCEPT IF URBAN TOWN.

(a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a person may serve on both a school board, however organized, and a town board of supervisors concurrently.

(b) This section does not apply to members of the town board of a town exercising the powers of a statutory city under section 368.01, or a special law.
