1.6	Section 1. [135A.012] HIGHER EDUCATION ATTAINMENT GOAL.
1.7	It is the goal of the state that by 2020 at least 75 percent of state residents at age
1.8	25 have attained a postsecondary degree or certificate. The goal is necessary so that the
1.9	people of the state have the necessary training to obtain the jobs that will be available in
1.10	2020 and so that employers will have a sufficient number of qualified employees.
