1.2 relating to public safety; requiring commissioner of public safety to seek a federal

1.3 waiver from passenger endorsement requirements on commercial driver's license.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE FEDERAL REGULATION**

1.6 **WAIVER REQUEST.**

1.7 The commissioner of public safety must apply to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety

1.8 Administration for a waiver from the federal regulation that requires a person to have a

1.9 passenger endorsement for driving a bus with no passengers for the sole purpose of delivering

1.10 the bus to the purchaser.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
