| 1.10              | Subd. 11a. Cremator operator. "Cremator operator" means a person who performs  |
| 1.11              | cremations at a licensed funeral establishment or licensed crematory.  |

## 3.16 <u>Subdivision 1.</u> Qualifications required. In order to perform cremations, a person must 3.17 satisfy the qualifications requirements in subdivision 2 or 3.

- 3.18 Subd. 2. Qualifications. (a) Before practicing as a cremator operator, a person must
- 3.19 provide documentation to the licensee employing the person that the person:
- 3.20 (1) is at least 18 years of age;

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- 3.21 (2) has actively participated in the performance of at least ten cremations that are
- 3.22 performed under the direct supervision of a cremator operator qualified under this subdivision
  3.23 or subdivision 3;
- 3.24 (3) has completed, within the year before beginning practice as a cremator operator, a
- 3.25 <u>course or training program on occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens that meets</u>
- 3.26 the requirements of Code of Federal Regulations, title 29, section 1910.1030(g)(2); and
- 3.27 (4) within the year before beginning practice as a cremator operator, obtained certification,
- 3.28 from an organization approved by the commissioner, that demonstrates the person's
- 3.29 knowledge of how to perform cremations.

- 3.31 requirements in paragraph (a), a person must provide documentation to the licensee
