1.8	Subd. 2e. Location equity revenue. (a) For a school district with more than 7,000
1.9	pupils in adjusted average daily membership or for any school district with any of its area
1.10	located within the seven-county metropolitan area, location equity revenue equals \$424
1.11	times the adjusted pupil units of the district for that school year.
1.12	(b) For all other school districts with more than 2,000 pupils in adjusted average
1.13	daily membership for the fiscal year ending in the year before the levy is certified, location
1.14	equity revenue equals \$212 times the adjusted pupil units of the district for that year.
1.15	(c) A district's location equity levy equals its location equity revenue times the lesser
1.16	of one or the ratio of its referendum market value per resident pupil unit to \$510,000. The

1.18	(d) A district's location equity aid equals its location equity revenue less its location
1.19	equity levy, times the ratio of the actual amount levied to the permitted levy.
