1.8	Subd. 4. Pavement management; remaining service life. (a) The commissioner must
1.9	incorporate the use of remaining service life into the department's pavement management
1.10	processes.
1.11	(b) Using remaining service life metrics that are current at the time each goal is set, the
1.12	department must set statewide pavement remaining service life goals of: (1) 12 years by
1.13	2021; and (2) 15 years by 2026.
1.14	(c) When each of the goals under paragraph (b) is met, the department must program
1.15	pavement spending so that: (1) the statewide pavement conditions do not drop below 15
1.16	years remaining service life; and (2) statewide pavement remaining service life does not
1.17	decrease in any year.
1.18	(d) The commissioner must collaborate with highway designers, highway engineers,
1.19	and highway construction industry members to develop and implement a pavement
1.20	management process that maximizes pavement remaining service life and return on
1.21	investment.
