2.14 (b) There is annually appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of  
2.15 education the amount necessary for early education scholarships according to paragraph

2.16 (a). This amount must be reduced by the amount of any money specifically appropriated  
2.17 for the same purpose in any year from any state fund.

2.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
