Section 1. **HISTORIC FORT SNELLING PRESERVATION AND**

IMPROVEMENT.

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$4,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

fund to the Minnesota Historical Society for predesign and design of facilities to support
- 1.10

visitor services and history programs at Historic Fort Snelling.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
- 1.13

bonds of the state in an amount up to \$4,400,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with

the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the

Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
