1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing municipalities to allow off-sales on Sundays;  
 1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 340A.504, subdivision 4.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 340A.504, subdivision 4, is amended to  
 1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 4. **Intoxicating liquor; off-sale.** (a) No sale of intoxicating liquor may  
 1.8 be made by an off-sale licensee:

1.9 (1) on Sundays;

1.10 (2) before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m. on Monday through Saturday;

1.11 (3) on Thanksgiving Day;

1.12 (4) on Christmas Day, December 25; or

1.13 (5) after 8:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve, December 24.

1.14 (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a municipality may authorize off-sale licensees

1.15 or a municipal liquor store under its jurisdiction to make off-sales of intoxicating liquor on

1.16 any day, provided that no sale may be made before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m.

1.17 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.18 Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
