1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for implementation of quiet

1.3zones in New Brighton; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **NEW BRIGHTON; QUIET ZONES.**

1.6Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$3,848,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.7to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of New Brighton to predesign,

1.8design, engineer, construct, and equip new passive and active rail grade crossing warning

1.9safety devices necessary to establish seven quiet zone areas at 11 grade crossings of railroad

1.10tracks and city streets. This appropriation does not require a nonstate contribution.

1.11Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.12proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.13the state in an amount up to \$3,848,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.14prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.15Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
