BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; LOCAL AND TRIBAL PUBLIC HEALTH

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE.

(a) \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated
- 1.8

from the general fund to the commissioner of health to be distributed to local and Tribal
- 1.9

public health organizations for emergency preparedness and response capabilities. Ninety
- 1.10

percent of this appropriation must be distributed to local and Tribal public health
- 1.11

organizations. Ten percent of this appropriation may be used by the Department of Health
- 1.12

for administrative costs.
- 1.13

(b) Use of the appropriation in this section must align with the Centers for Disease
- 1.14

Control and Prevention's issued report: Public Health Emergency Preparedness and Response
- 1.15

Capabilities: National Standards for State, Local, Tribal, and Territorial Public Health.

(c) The base for fiscal year 2026 and each fiscal year thereafter is \$9,000,000.
