- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to government operations; agriculture; authorizing expedited rulemaking
- 1.3 for industrial hemp; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 18K.06.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 18K.06, is amended to read:
- 1.6 **18K.06 RULEMAKING.**
- 1.7 (a) The commissioner shall adopt rules governing the production, testing, and licensing
- 1.8 of industrial hemp.
- 1.9 (b) Rules adopted under paragraph (a) must include, but not be limited to, provisions
- 1.10 governing:
- 1.11 (1) the supervision and inspection of industrial hemp during its growth and harvest;
- 1.12 (2) the testing of industrial hemp to determine delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol levels;
- 1.13 (3) the use of background check results required under section 18K.04 to approve or
- 1.14 deny a license application; and
- 1.15 (4) any other provision or procedure necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter.
- 1.16 (c) Rules issued under this section must be consistent with federal law regarding the
- 1.17 production, distribution, and sale of industrial hemp.
- 1.18 (d) The commissioner may use the expedited rulemaking process in section 14.389 to
- 1.19 adopt the rules required under this section that are required to conform to the Agriculture
- 1.20 Improvement Act of 2018, Public Law 115-1072, and federal rules authorized under that
- 1.21 act.
