1.4	Section 1. BICYCLE LIGHT SAFETY PILOT PROGRAM; APPROPRIATION.
1.5	(a) An amount equal to the undesignated fund balance in the bicycle transportation
1.6	account in the special revenue fund created in Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 168C.04,
1.7	subdivision 2, is appropriated from that account to the commissioner of public safety
1.8	in fiscal year 2012, for a bicycle light safety pilot program. The commissioner shall
1.9	establish the program to: procure head lamps for bicycles; coordinate with one local law
