EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.

Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION.

\$250,000 is appropriated from the general fund in fiscal year 2015 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for an evaluation of the future federal financial support for broadband infrastructure deployment in rural Minnesota. The commissioner shall develop state strategies to maximize federal financial assistance for

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2.1	broadband infrastructure deployment in rural Minnesota. The commissioner shall develop
2.2	state policy alternatives to respond to possible changes in federal telecommunications
2.3	regulation and funding level reductions that impact deployment of broadband
2.4	infrastructure in rural Minnesota. The commissioner may contract for the performance of

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any or all of the commissioner's duties under this section.

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
