BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7

Section 1. **WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; KEEWATIN; NASHWAUK;**

1.8

LONE PINE TOWNSHIP; AND GREENWAY TOWNSHIP.

1.9

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$850,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.10

to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to a joint powers authority entered into by the

1.11

city of Keewatin, the city of Nashwauk, Lone Pine Township, and Greenway Township to

1.12

predesign, design, and engineer a regional wastewater treatment system located in the city

1.13

of Nashwauk to serve the communities represented by the joint powers authority and other

1.14

communities. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and

1.15

budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project,

1.16

as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.

1.17

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.18

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.19

the state in an amount up to \$850,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.20

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.21

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.22

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
