5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
6	Section 1. [299C.26] ELECTRONIC DEVICE SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT.
7	Subdivision 1. Possession. The Bureau of Criminal Apprehension is the sole
8	governmental entity authorized to own or possess a piece of electronic device surveillance
9	equipment.
10	Subd. 2. Temporary use. Upon written application, the superintendent may
11	authorize a law enforcement agency to use a piece of electronic device surveillance
12	equipment controlled by the bureau for investigatory purposes. The application must
13	contain a detailed explanation of the designated investigation and include copies of valid
14	search warrants, when required by law.
15	Subd. 3. Surrender. An agency, other than the bureau, that possesses a piece of
16	electronic device surveillance equipment on the effective date of this law, must surrender
17	the device to the superintendent within 30 days of the law taking effect.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This act is effective the day following final enactment. 2.9
