Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$3,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds  
fund to the commissioner of economic development for a grant to the city of Albert Lea  
for predesign, design, site work, and construction, including the relocation of Front Street,  
for Phase I of the Blazing Star Landing project to redevelop the former Farmland Foods  
property along Albert Lea Lake.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the  
bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue  
bonds of the state in an amount up to \$3,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with  
the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the  
Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
