**OFFICIAL STATUS**

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for improvements at the  
1.3 Olmsted County materials recovery facility; authorizing the sale and issuance of  
1.4 state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **OLMSTED COUNTY; FOOD SEPARATION SYSTEM.**

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$3,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund  
1.8 to the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to Olmsted County to  
1.9 design, construct, and equip a food waste separation system to prepare food waste for  
1.10 recycling purposes at an organic materials management facility.

1.11 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond  
1.12 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of  
1.13 the state in an amount up to \$3,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect  
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota  
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
