| 1.13 | of United States Department of Agriculture commodities under the Emergency Food |

| 1.16 | not limited to, information on the expenditure of funds, the amount of milk purchased, and |
| 1.17 | the organizations to which the milk was distributed. Second Harvest Heartland may enter |
| 1.18 | into contracts or agreements with food banks for shared funding or reimbursement of the |
| 1.19 | direct purchase of milk. Each food bank receiving money from this appropriation may use |
| 1.20 | up to two percent of the grant for administrative expenses. This appropriation is in addition |
