1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to human services; providing for a payment to Lifeworks Services, Inc.,

1.3for a disability inclusion pilot project; appropriating money.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; DISABILITY INCLUSION PILOT PROJECT.**

1.6\$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7of human services for a payment to Lifeworks Services, Inc., for a statewide disability

1.8inclusion pilot project. The pilot project must endeavor to educate people with disabilities

1.9to increase their knowledge of resources and encourage advocacy for full and equal access

1.10and opportunities in all aspects of life; train parents, guardians, and families to understand

1.11the disability service system and see beyond preconceived barriers; persuade employers to

1.12diversify their workforces by hiring people with disabilities; build capacity and support for

1.13culturally specific services led by entrepreneurs and business owners from rural communities

1.14and who are immigrants, Black, Indigenous, and people of color; and launch a statewide

1.15disability inclusion assessment program for businesses and community spaces so people

1.16with disabilities know that they will be welcomed, that physical spaces will be accessible,

1.17and that interactions will be free from discrimination. This is a onetime appropriation.
