1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the Spirit Mountain Recreation Area
1.10	Authority to acquire easements, licenses, and other interests in real property and to
1.11	engineer, design, permit, and construct works and systems to transport water from the St.
1.12	Louis River estuary for commercial and industrial use. This appropriation is not available
