1.5	Section 1. COUNSELING FOR COLLEGE STUDENT LOAN DEBTORS.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Pilot program created. The commissioner of the Office of Higher
1.7	Education shall make a grant to a nonprofit qualified debt counseling organization to
1.8	provide individual student loan debt repayment counseling to borrowers who are Minnesota
1.9	residents concerning loans obtained to attend a Minnesota postsecondary institution. The
1.10	counseling shall be provided to borrowers who are 30 to 60 days delinquent when they are
