1.9	pharmacist or other dispenser more than 30 days after the date on which the prescription

1.11	(b) No prescription drug order for an opioid drug listed in Schedules III through V may
1.12	be initially dispensed by a pharmacist or other dispenser more than 30 days after the date
1.13	on which the prescription drug order was issued. No prescription drug order for an opioid
1.14	<u>drug listed in Schedules III through V may be refilled by a pharmacist or other dispenser</u>
1.15	more than 30 days after the previous date on which it was dispensed.
