- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 152.11, is amended by adding a subdivision
- 1.6 to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 5. Limitations on the dispensing of opioid prescription drug orders. (a) No
- 1.8 prescription drug order for an opioid drug listed in Schedule II may be dispensed by a
- 1.9 pharmacist or other dispenser more than 30 days after the date on which the prescription
- 1.10 drug order was issued.
- 1.11 (b) No prescription drug order for an opioid drug listed in Schedules III through V may
- 1.12 be initially dispensed by a pharmacist or other dispenser more than 30 days after the date
- 1.13 on which the prescription drug order was issued. No prescription drug order for an opioid
- 1.14 drug listed in Schedules III through V may be refilled by a pharmacist or other dispenser
- 1.15 more than 30 days after the previous date on which it was dispensed.
- 1.16 (c) For purposes of this section, "dispenser" has the meaning given in section 152.126,
- 1.17 subdivision 1.
