1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 561.19, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 2. Agricultural operation not a nuisance. (a) An agricultural operation is not
1.8	and shall not become a private or public nuisance after two years from its established date
1.9	of operation as a matter of law if the operation:
1.10	(1) is located in an agriculturally zoned area;
1.11	(2) complies with the provisions of all applicable federal, state, or county laws,
1.12	regulations, rules, and ordinances and any permits issued for the agricultural operation; and
1.13	(3) operates according to generally accepted agricultural practices.
1.14	(b) For a period of two years from its established date of operation, there is a rebuttable
1.15	presumption that an agricultural operation in compliance with the requirements of paragraph

(1) to an animal feedlot facility with a swine capacity of 1,000 or more animal units as
