Sec. 2. FARMER-LENDER MEDIATION TASK FORCE.

The commissioner of agriculture must convene an advisory task force to provide 1 15 recommendations to the legislature regarding the state's Farmer-Lender Mediation Act. 1.16 The task force must be comprised of 12 members including one adult farm business 1.17 management instructor appointed by the commissioner and three farmers appointed by 1.18 the commissioner, at least one of whom is a beginning or nontraditional farmer and at 1.19 least one of whom has personal experience with the farmer-lender mediation program. 1.20 The remaining membership of the task force consists of one member appointed by each 1.21 of the following entities: 1.22
