1.5	Section 1. SOUTHWEST MINNESOTA REGIONAL AMATEUR SPORTS

1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission for a grant to the city of Marshall
1.9	to acquire land and prepare a site for, and to design, construct, furnish, and equip the
1.10	Southwest Minnesota Regional Amateur Sports Center. This appropriation is available
