1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to counties; allowing a county law library to transfer money to the county

1.3 for certain construction costs; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,

1.4 chapter 134A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [134A.17] TRANSFERS TO COUNTY.

1.7 If a county law library, through its trustees, has a fiscal reserve that is projected to sustain

1.8 its operations for a period of over five years, the county law library may transfer up to half

1.9 of the money in its fiscal reserve, but not to exceed \$200,000, to the county in which the

1.10 library is located to defray costs of constructing a new building to house the law library and

1.11 courts.
