BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 340A.412, is amended by adding a

subdivision to read:

Subd. 12a. **Wine transfers.** Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 12, the

1.9

holder of a retail intoxicating liquor license may transfer wine from one licensed premises

1.10

to another provided that:

1.11

(1) the license for the transferring and receiving premises are held by the same

1.12

licensee; and

1.13

(2) only one transfer is made from a licensed premises in a three-month period.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
