1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 103G.2372, subdivision 1, is amended to

1.8	Subdivision 1. Authority; orders. (a) The commissioner of natural resources,
1.9	conservation officers, and peace officers shall enforce laws preserving and protecting
1.10	groundwater quantity, wetlands, and public waters. The commissioner of natural resources,
1.11	a conservation officer, or a peace officer may issue a cease and desist order to stop any
1.12	illegal activity adversely affecting groundwater quantity, a wetland, or public waters.
1.13	(b) In the order, or by separate order, the commissioner, conservation officer, or peace
1.14	officer may require restoration or replacement of the wetland or public waters, as determined
1.15	by the local soil and water conservation district for wetlands and the commissioner of natural
1.16	resources for public waters. Restoration or replacement orders may be recorded or filed in
1.17	the office of the county recorder or registrar of titles, as appropriate, in the county where
1.18	the real property is located by the commissioner of natural resources, conservation officers,

2.2	order, an order may not be recorded or filed under this section.
2.3	(d) If an order was recorded or filed before the effective date of this section and the deed
2.4	restriction would have been in violation of paragraph (c), the commissioner must remove
2.5	the deed restriction if the owner of the property requests the commissioner to remove it.
