1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT

1.7	(a) \$150,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$150,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from
1.8	the general fund to the commissioner of transportation for grants to transportation
