1.5	Section 1. PIONEERS AND SOLDIERS CEMETERY RESTORATION.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,900,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the Minnesota Historical Society for a grant to the city of Minneapolis to restore
1.8	the historic steel and limestone pillar fence along Cedar Avenue and Lake Street, install a
1.9	new steel fence and pillars along 21st Avenue South, and install a waterproofing system
