Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 103G.005, is amended by adding a subdivision 1.6 to read: 1.7 Subd. 8a. Constructed management facilities for storm water. "Constructed 1.8 management facilities for storm water" means ponds, basins, holding tanks, cisterns, trenches, 1.9 swales, or other best management practices that have been designed, constructed, and 1.10 operated to store or treat storm water. 1.11 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 103G.271, subdivision 1, is amended to read: 1.12 Subdivision 1. Permit required. (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the state, a 1.13 person, partnership, or association, private or public corporation, county, municipality, or 1.14 other political subdivision of the state may not appropriate or use waters of the state without 1.15 a water-use permit from the commissioner. 1.16 (b) This section does not apply to use for a water supply by less than 25 persons for 1.17 domestic purposes, except as required by the commissioner under section 103G.287, 1.18 subdivision 4, paragraph (b). 1.19 (c) The commissioner may issue a state general permit for appropriation of water to a 1.20 governmental subdivision or to the general public. The general permit may authorize more 1.21 than one project and the appropriation or use of more than one source of water. Water-use
