1.5	Section 1. POSTSECONDARY TUITION PROGRAM TASK FORCE.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Establishment. The commissioner of education, in collaboration
1.7	with the president of the University of Minnesota and the chancellor of the Minnesota State
1.8	Colleges and Universities, shall appoint an advisory task force by July 1, 2014, to research
1.9	the establishment and operation of an endowment that pays the tuition of any public school
1.10	student who gains admission to a public higher educational institution in Minnesota.
1.11	Subd. 2. Duties. The duties of the task force include:
