- (b) Members of the advisory committee appointed by the governor serve at the pleasure of the governor. Members of the advisory committee serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses as determined by the Metropolitan Council. The advisory committee expires December 31, 2012 2016.
- (c) The council must consider the work and recommendations of the advisory committee when the council is preparing its regional development framework.
