1.6	Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section, "I-494 rehabilitation
1.7	project" means the trunk highway project programmed on the effective date of this section
1.8	to reconstruct marked Interstate Highway 494, maintain associated bridges from the
1.9	interchange with marked Interstate Highway 394 to the interchange with marked Interstate
1.10	Highways 94 and 694, and establish dynamic shoulder lanes along the segment of marked
