The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Transportation Finance and Policy Division

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to driver's licenses; amending the time period for certain loss of driving
- 1.3 privileges due to a driving-related episode of loss of consciousness or voluntary
- 1.4 control; providing for rulemaking.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **LOSS OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES; ADMINISTRATIVE RULES.**
- 1.7 (a) The commissioner of public safety must amend Minnesota Rules, part 7410.2610,
- 1.8 subpart 5a, item B, to establish a cancellation period of 30 days from the date of a
- 1.9 driving-related episode of loss of consciousness or voluntary control due to hypoglycemia
- 1.10 or hyperglycemia, when (1) the episode is the person's first driving-related episode, and (2)
- 1.11 the person reports the episode and provides a physician's statement as required under
- 1.12 Minnesota Rules, part 7410.2610, subparts 3 and 3a.
- 1.13 (b) The commissioner may use the expedited process in Minnesota Statutes, section
- 1.14 14.389, for rulemaking under paragraph (a).
- 1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
