## Section 1. WELLHEAD PROTECTION; BONDS. 1.5

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. (a) \$20,000,000 is appropriated from the bond 1.6 proceeds fund to the commissioner of health for competitive grants to public water 1.7

suppliers to acquire land in fee to protect community water systems within drinking 1.8

water supply management areas with very high and high vulnerability to contamination. 19

Land acquired in fee under this paragraph must be maintained in a manner that protects 1 10

groundwater from contamination and may be used to provide multiple benefits, including: 1.11

wildlife habitat; park, trail, and other open space; and land for the installation of solar and 1.12

wind energy facilities. To be eligible for a grant under this section, a public water supplier 1.13

must have a wellhead protection plan or alternative water source protection plan for river 1.14

or other surface water sources approved by the commissioner of health. Priority must be 1.15

given to projects that provide multiple benefits and are matched with other state funds 1.16

for those purposes, including the outdoor heritage fund, the clean water fund, and the 1.17

environment and natural resources trust fund. Any money earned from the installation of 1 18

solar and wind energy facilities installed on land purchased under this paragraph must be 1 19

used for the acquisition of additional land for the purposes of this paragraph. 1.20

(b) \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner 1.21
