1.8	Subd. 15. <b>Residential heating fuels.</b> Residential heating fuels are exempt as follows:
1.9	(1) all fuel oil, coal, wood, steam, hot water, propane gas, biomass as defined in
1.10	section 216B.2411, subdivision 2, paragraph (c), and L.P. gas sold to residential customers
1.11	for residential use;
1.12	(2) for the billing months of November, December, January, February, March, and
1.13	April, natural gas sold for residential use to customers who are metered and billed as
1.14	residential users and who use natural gas for their primary source of residential heat; and
1.15	(3) for the billing months of November, December, January, February, March, and
1.16	April, electricity sold for residential use to customers who are metered and billed as
1.17	residential users and who use electricity for their primary source of residential heat.
