1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money to make repairs and construct
1.3 new facilities at the Spirit Mountain Recreation Area in Duluth; authorizing the
1.4 sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. SPIRIT MOUNTAIN RECREATION AREA.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$13,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city
1.9 of Duluth to design, construct, furnish, and equip new facilities and to renew, replace, and
1.10 repair existing facilities at the Spirit Mountain Recreation Area.

1.11 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.12 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.13 the state in an amount up to \$13,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
