1.6	Section 1. [129D.165] GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES.
1.7	(a) Money appropriated from the general fund for grants to arts organizations may
1.8	be awarded only to an organization that:
1.9	(1) is physically located in Minnesota and demonstrates that a majority of its arts
1.10	programming, services, and activities takes place in Minnesota and that the organization
1.11	primarily serves and engages Minnesota audiences and participants; or
1.12	(2) is located in a community that is on the border between Minnesota and another
1.13	state and demonstrates that it is providing arts programming, services, or activities to
1.14	Minnesota residents that would not otherwise be available to Minnesota residents.
1.15	(b) Money appropriated from the general fund to an organization described in
