1.3 requirements; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 326B.164, subdivision

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 326B.164, subdivision 13, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 13. ~~Exemption~~ **Exemptions from licensing.** (a) Employees of a licensed elevator
1.8 contractor or licensed limited elevator contractor are not required to hold or obtain a license
1.9 under this section or be provided with direct supervision by a licensed master elevator
1.10 constructor, licensed limited master elevator constructor, licensed elevator constructor, or
1.11 licensed limited elevator constructor to install, maintain, or repair platform lifts and stairway
1.12 chairlifts. Unlicensed employees performing elevator work under this exemption must
1.13 comply with subdivision 5. This exemption does not include the installation, maintenance,
1.14 repair, or replacement of electrical wiring for elevator equipment.

1.15 (b) The requirements of this section do not apply to elevator work in a residential
1.16 dwelling.
