1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [116J.4012] OCCUPATIONAL EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS SURVEY.

1.6 An employer who receives an occupational employment statistics survey pursuant to
1.7 United States Code, title 29, section 2, is required to provide the department with information
1.8 required by the survey for each employee, including but not limited to job title and hourly
1.9 or annual wage data.
